The nearest parking garage is the 10<sup>th</sup> Street garage. It has a capacity of 700 vehicles. The fee is determined by the management, <https://alcoparking.com/>.

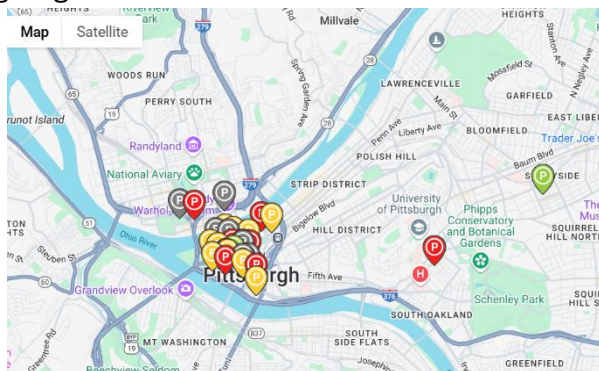
On the day of the ceremony, many other events will be happening downtown, so the garage could be full. In addition, there may be construction projects in the region, leading to travel delays.

Please make arrangements in advance to know what your parking alternatives are and allow additional time to walk to the Convention Center.

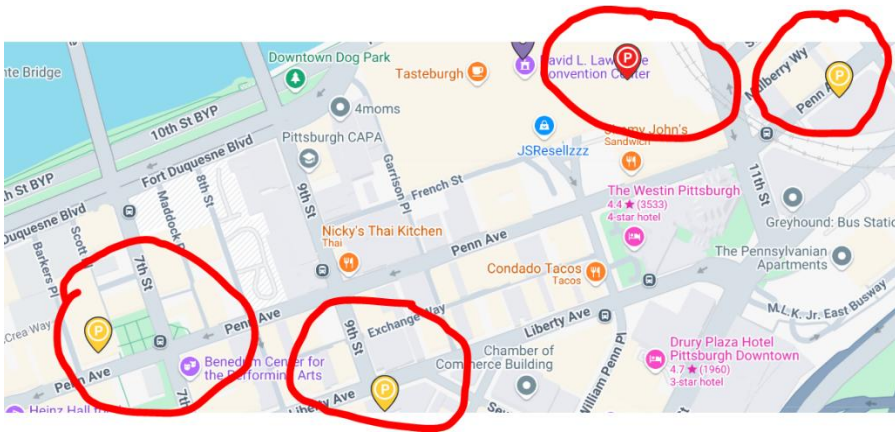
There are two useful parking apps that you can download to assist in your parking planning. Both apps are free.

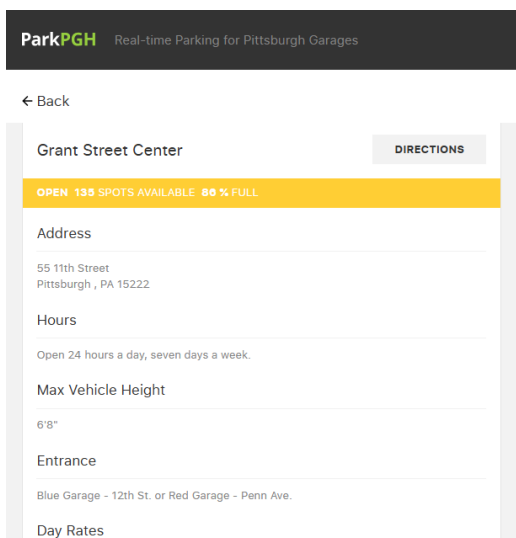
1. Go to <https://www.parkpgh.org/> for real time information about downtown parking garages.



2. Under the destinations tab, select the David L. Lawrence Convention Center (under “D” for David).
3. The nearest parking garages are these:

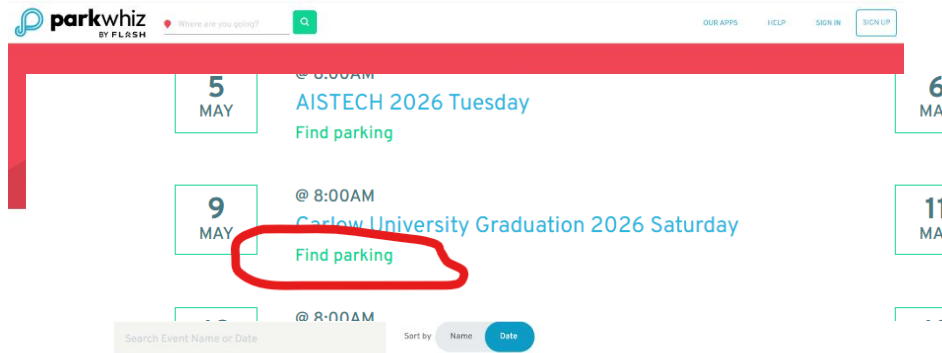


- a. 10<sup>th</sup> Street
  - b. Grant Street Center – 55 11<sup>th</sup> Street
  - c. Smithfield & Liberty – 629 Smithfield Street
  - d. Theater Square – 120 7<sup>th</sup> Street
4. The color of the “P” icon on the map indicates the availability of parking at that moment:
    - a. Red – full
    - b. Yellow – nearly full
    - c. Green – not full
  5. By clicking on the “P” icon, it will take you to the detail page of that garage: address, hours, max vehicle height, and price, as well as availability. Here is an example:

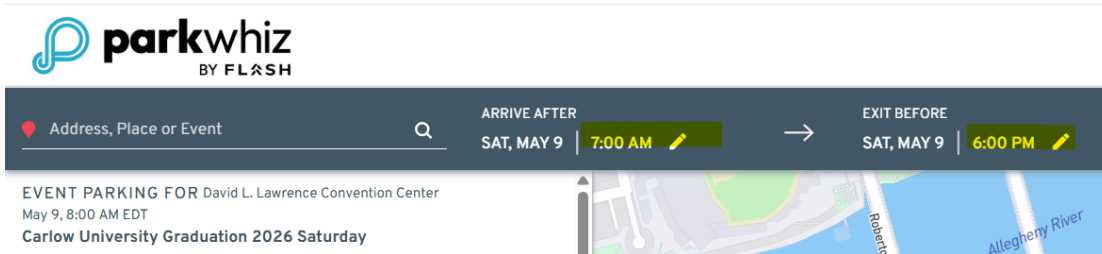


## Pre-Paid Advance Parking Reservations at [ParkWhiz](https://www.parkwhiz.com/)

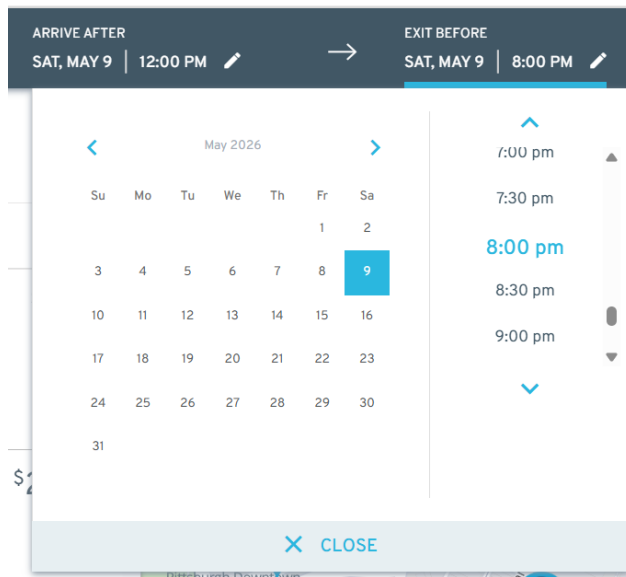
1. Go to <https://www.parkwhiz.com/> and enter David L. Lawrence Convention Center into the search engine.



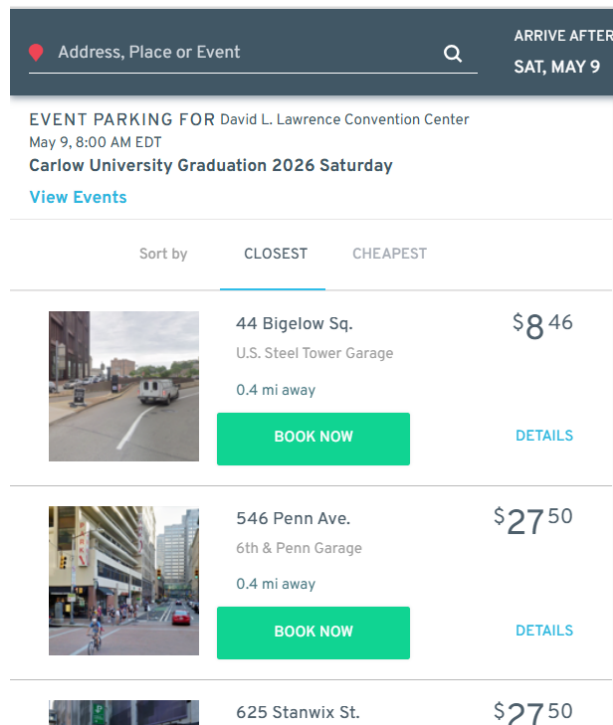
2. Scroll down to May 9 and the Carlow University Graduation Ceremony and select “Find parking”



3. Edit your entry and exit times.



4. Reserve and pay for your parking space. Note: not all parking garages in the city are available to reserve on the ParkWhiz app.



5. After paying, ParkWhiz will send you a QR code, which you will need to scan upon entrance and exit.
